If you missed the conference this year stay tuned there may be a follow up next year.

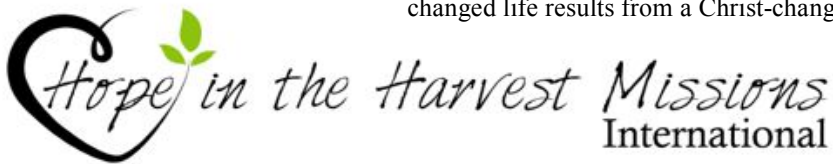


THANKS FOR YOUR SUPPORT
